# HEY FOLKS

Your assistance is needed. AQH is searching for a farm or parcel of land for hunting quail, doves, and training bird dogs. In an effort to find property, we have two ads running to lease property, we have made numerous calls to Blount County land owners and we have toured one farm with the owner. Another woodland parcel was seen in St Clair County, but neither has been that special piece of property we need.

Therefore, I am asking for your help. We need 125 acres or more with large open fields, or a fresh clear cut located in an isolated area, without houses bordering the boundary. Preferably, we would like it to be located about an hour's drive from Birmingham. That place is scarce but it does exist. The land owner you know may be someone just waiting for the right group to develop quail habitat. We are looking for a place that someone is not currently leasing. We do not wish to drive someone away from their lease. We need a multiple year lease. If you know of a likely piece of property, please take a few steps to learn if a farm is available before recommending it. Ideally, we need an older land owner that recalls the old days of bird hunting, one that would like for the bob white whistle to return to his/her farm.

In September we will be meeting at Cahaba Outfitters in lieu of a regular meeting. Tim Webster has offered us the use of his place all day, so plan to come early and enjoy some time in the outdoors. Be sure to thank Tim for offering us the use of his place.
